

Care instructions merino wool

Merino wool is a particularly soft product that is often incorporated into more luxurious products. The wool of the merino sheep provides many advantages. Among other things, merino wool contains a special wax layer that has the capability to self-clean. This means that you don't have to wash the item as often. In addition, the material is very hard-wearing and does not itch.

If you do want to wash your garment made of merino wool, it is best to do so by hand. This will keep your garment looking good for longer compared to machine washing. Read the instructions below carefully.

Hand wash

Merino wool stays beautiful for a long time if you wash it by hand. First soak the clothes in lukewarm water (max 30°C) for 5-10 minutes. Then wash it in water with a small amount of detergent that is suitable for wool. Gently squeeze the soapy water through it. Then rinse it in cold water.

Press as much water out of the garment as possible, but do not wring!

Delicate machine wash 30°C

If you do prefer to use the washing machine, wash the garment on a wool wash program at 30°C maximum. Use a wool detergent and set the spinning speed to 600 rpm maximum.



Only dry flat

Products with (merino) wool are best dried flat. This way it will keep its shape and will not stretch due to the weight of the water. In addition, woolen garments should not be tumble-dried. This increases the risk of shrinkage.

Iron max 110°C

Ironing restores the fit of your merino wool garment. Do not iron too hot and preferably use steam. Or use an iron setting that is suitable for wool.

Do not bleach

Dry clean

If you wish, you can take your woolen garment to the dry cleaner.
